Construction of a multi-purpose sports hall

Construction of a multi-use sports area in the context of the Léopold Club, including two covered pitches, a fitness space, changing rooms and a “casual” bar.

It was essential for this development to respect the beauty of the 5 hectare park with its reliefs and plantations.

The views from the terraces of the main club-house had to be preserved and the solution was to “set” the building within the bowl of the former central court, which also enabled the spoil factor to be kept to a minimum.

The works were completed in 10 months, including the development of the surrounding approach areas.
